Lead by Co-Captains (and exes) Aurelia and Sim, STARSHIP Q STAR follows this extremely queer crew on their quest across the galaxy to find a new home.



OVERVIEW

Created by co-writing queer couple Meegan May & Lauren Anderson, STARSHIP O STAR is a full cast sci-fi comedy starring some of Melbourne's hottest comedic and talent. Independently produced to global chart success and awards, the podcast was recentlu chosen for the ABC 8 Australia's Fresh Blood initiative to produce animated episodes based the series.

When exes and Co-Captains AURELIA and SIM are charged with a historic mission - the 'first all non-men crew' to go to Mars - they are desperate to declare 'mission complete' and never see each other again. But when they find out that Earth has been destroyed, they must work together to lead their very queer crew across the galaxy in search of a new home.

the real-life Looselu based on NASA proposal of all-female teams for long haul space missions to prevent sex and pregnancy (perhaps a little bit misinterpreted in the media...), the crew of the Starship Q Star don't guite manage to avoid this... Ruleobsessed soldier Sim free-spirited and scientist Aurelia must navigate feelings and new Co-Captaining challenges. Turns out job sharing with your ex ain't easy - especially when they're one sixth of the entire human population.

With the lothario Medical Officer MO, cocky ace pilot DUSTY, and eccentric teen-genius engineer SOLARIS; the team are eventually joined by the last man alive, BOB, a sweet but clueless botanist who was accidentally left behind on the flailing Mars colony.





Together they adventure from planet to planet encountering enticing new worlds, strange creatures, and bizarre civilisations. An increasingly complicated queer love web emerges as the crew of the Starship Q Star give in to their human urges with each other and aliens alike. But when the crew finally think that they've found their new home, they discover a strange beacon, signalling them from across the galaxy...

STARSHIP Q STAR is about finding connection in an isolated universe – and seeing the destruction of Earth as a great opportunity to find a new way of doing things. And on a ship of raging queers with two exgirlfriends at the helm... what could possibly go wrong?

The cast and crew across the podcast and animated series represent an intersection of diverse creatives, with a particular focus on queer and gender diverse artists.

The STARSHIP Q STAR podcast was supported by the City of Melbourne and the Victorian Government through Creative Victoria, and the animated series was produced by So Nice Productions with support from the ABC and Screen Australia

The Creators

Collaborating since 2017, in love since 2018 - together Lauren Anderson & Meegan May have written the award-winning comedy short THE GINGER CONSPIRACY and a short work for Theatre Works as part of the Green Room Award winning SHE IS VIGILANTE. Their first full length play, THE COUNTDOWN, was developed as part of a residency with Theatre Works.

Their creation STARSHIP Q STAR was shortlisted for the Australian Writers' Guild / Audible Podcast writing competition and receiving funding from Creative Victoria and the City of Melbourne. They were both chosen to take part in Co-Curious's STORIES FROM ANOTHER AUSTRALIA initiative, and are now overseeing the production of three animated shorts based on STARSHIP Q STAR.

As showrunners for STARSHIP, Lauren and Meegan have overseen the entire process from concept development to production and post.

Lauren Anderson is a writer and producer who works across scripted and unscripted television, the stage and audio. She is passionate about creating works that surprise, entertain, and explore emotion and heart in the most unexpected of places.

Her short films have won numerous awards including a nomination for the Iris Prize. Lauren has regularly worked in the writers' rooms of Guesswork Television since 2017 and has undertaken a Screen Victoria funded writers' placement with EndemolShine Banks. Lauren has written on comedy animation series KITTY IS NOT A CAT (season 2 and 3) and is regularly on an island creating twists as a senior creative producer on the award-winning AUSTRALIAN SURVIVOR.

Meegan May (<u>www.meeganmay.com</u>)

Meegan May is an emerging writer and former military intelligence analyst. A decorated ex-soldier and veteran of the Afghanistan conflict, Meegan spent nearly five years working in military intelligence. Her TV project VIEWERS, written during her MFA in screenwriting, was shortlisted in the Australian Writers' Guild's John Hinde Award and Final Draft's Big Break Competition among others. Her recent scifi pilot WATCHME found similar success in these contests in 2022.

Meegan has worked extensively in development, including as Assistant Scripted Development Producer at Seven Studios, and as a prolific writer's assistant including on projects for Netflix, Amazon Prime's DEADLOCH, and Disney +'s THE ARTFUL DODGER.

Meegan now works regularly as a writer and is the creator and writer of Quinn Original audio series COMPROMISED, starring Victoria Pedretti.
